

Test Schedule

- Master** – 8:30 am or at judge’s discretion; braces drawn at 8:15 am.
- Senior** – 10:00 am or following completion of Master class.
- Introduction to Quarry** – 9:00 am.
- Junior** – 1:00 pm or following completion of Senior; whichever is later.

Any dog not ready when called shall be moved to the end of the running order, except in the Master class. In the Master class, any dog not present within 5 minutes after its brace is called will be marked absent by the Judge. The remaining dog in that brace will run as or with the bye dog.

Please be on time for your class but above all, be flexible. Delays are not uncommon. Lunch will be called at the judges’ discretion.

Close of Entries

Entries close one-half hour before the published start time for each test. Dogs entering Master must pre-enter with the exception of dogs earning their senior title on Saturday (those dogs may move up).

Pre-entry discounts apply only to entries received by the test secretary before 4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 5.

Note: Large Intro classes may not be completed prior to the close of entries for the Junior class. If you are considering entering your dog in both Intro and Junior, we encourage you to pre-enter Intro.

Tests and Awards

Introduction to Quarry – Open to all dogs. Nonregular class; dogs do not earn a title in this class. Qualifiers receive a flat ribbon.

Junior Earthdog – Open to all dogs except dogs that have received a Senior qualifying leg. Qualifiers receive a rosette ribbon.

Senior Earthdog – Open to all dogs that have earned a JE before the close of entries. Qualifiers receive a rosette ribbon.

Master Earthdog – Open to all dogs that have earned an SE before close of entries. Qualifiers receive a rosette ribbon.

Iron Dog - Open to all dogs that have earned an ME before close of entries. Non-regular class; dogs do not earn a title in this class. Dogs must qualify in both the Master and Senior classes on the same day to receive the Iron Dog qualifying prize. An entry form for each class (Senior and Master) must be completed.

New Titles – OTEEC offers an embroidered bandana to dogs that complete a title at an OTEEC test.

Junior Handlers

Notice to Exhibitors

- Earthdog tests are held rain or shine. Oregon weather is unpredictable. Bring both shade and rain cover for you and your dog.
- Dogs may enter only one regular class. Dogs with Master titles may enter more than one regular class. Dogs need not qualify in Intro to enter the Junior Earthdog class.
- The running order will be posted and followed using AKC rules. This includes pre-entries.
- Dogs must be kept on leash and under control while on the grounds.
- Dogs are not allowed within 100 feet of the test areas.
- As bitches in season are not eligible, please leave them at home or confine them to your setup.
- This test is being held on private property. Please honor posted signs, notices, and any requests or directions from the site owner.
- Pick up after your dog. No exceptions!
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of OTEEC, it is impossible to begin or complete these tests, no refund of entries will be given.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for any checks returned for insufficient funds.

Eligibility: Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests: Dachshunds, Australian Terriers, Bedlington Terriers, Border Terriers, Cairn Terriers, Cesky Terriers, Dandie Dinmont Terriers, Glen of Imaal Terriers, Fox Terriers (Smooth and Wirehaired), Lakeland Terriers, Manchester Terriers, Miniature Bull Terriers, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk Terriers, Norwich Terriers, Parson Russell Terriers, Rat Terriers, Scottish Terriers, Sealyham Terriers, Silky Terriers, Skye Terriers, Welsh Terriers and West Highland White Terriers. Dogs of an eligible breed that have been granted Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test and shall not be allowed within 100 feet of any testing area during the running of any class. Bitches in season are allowed at the general test site but should not be allowed to distract other dogs during the test hours.

The Oregon Trail's End Earthdog Club and its officers assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injuries to any child not under the control of his/her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, handler, or spectator whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviors may, at the discretion of the Test Committee, be asked to leave the Test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
